

Hawana Salalah Marina

The 170-berth inland marina is the natural heart of Muriya's Hawana Salalah destination. Built in close proximity to the ancient UNESCO Heritage Site Khor Ruri, which flourished for over 500 years as a major frankincense port, the marina offers easy access to open water and is the only yacht haven on the south coast of the Sultanate.

Designed with the capacity to hold 100 more yachts in its dry berths, the marina is equipped to handle boats up to 60m in length, and there are dedicated service pillars on each berth, providing all electricity and water, with 24-hour security. It is also an ideal base for visiting the Hallaniyat Islands with the chance to see humpback whales and the best sports fishing grounds.

The marina, the vibrant heart of Hawana Salalah, caters to the diverse needs of seafarers looking for sea adventures, fishing and diving trips as well as unwinding excursions. The marina itself is filled with biodiversity with catfish, lobster, queen fish, and sardines calling it home. From the breakwater guests can fish with ease, watch dolphins emerge from the ocean, and unwind with the calming waves. Its promenade has witnessed the opening of several F&B venues, with several more set to open their doors in the coming months.
