

SALALAH BEACH MARINA

The 171-berth inland marina is the natural heart of Muriya's Salalah Beach destination. Built in close proximity to the ancient but now unused Khor Ruri, which was a major trading post in the days of the frankincense trade, and the modern Port of Salalah, the Marina offers easy access to open water and is the only yacht haven on the south coast of the Sultanate.

Designed with the capacity to hold 100 more yachts in its dry berths, the Marina is equipped to handle boats up to 60m in length, and there are dedicated service pillars on each berth, providing all electricity and water, with 24-hour security. It is also an ideal base for visiting the Hallaniyat Islands with the chance to see humpback whales and some of the best sports fishing grounds. The Marina at the heart of the vibrant Salalah Beach caters to the diverse needs of seafarers looking for outstanding service, superb dining, entertainment, as well as leisure propositions. Its promenade has witnessed the opening of several F&B venues, with several more set to open their doors to Salalah Beach's community in the coming months.
